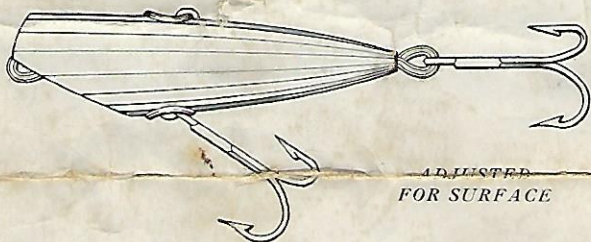


"A 'LIAR' always gets the most and biggest fish"

The "LIAR" Swimming Minnow

Can be used as a Surface Bait or an Under-Water Wabblers.

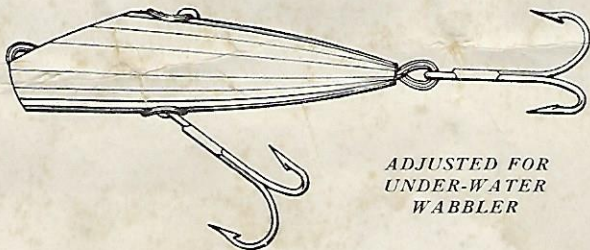
It **floats** when not in motion.



ADJUSTED
FOR SURFACE

As a SURFACE BAIT for use at night, or fishing over shallow water, over submerged weeds, etc., the LIAR has a peculiar skipping motion which makes it the most attractive of all surface baits.

As an UNDER WATER WABBLER it has the erratic wobble, wiggle and darting movements of a live minnow, which deceives the most skeptical fish who only take chances on things that appear natural.

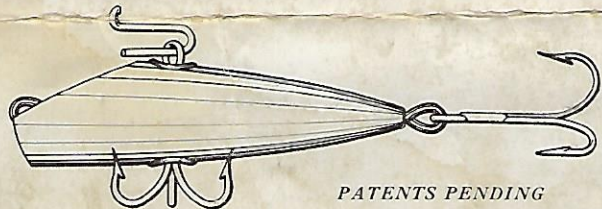


ADJUSTED FOR

To MAKE the CHANGE from one to the other push the hook through the bait, as shown in the cut below.

Remove the hook retaining loop, withdraw the hook, insert the hook from the other side of the bait, replace loop in eye of hook, pull hook through until lug on the loop rests on top of the bait.

Remember: The lug should always point toward the tail of the bait. The hook should hang with one hook forward and two back as shown in the above cuts.

The bait is worked to best advantage by reeling slowly.
